## TALK ABOUT IT

**Read:** Luke 2

### Talk about it:

- After Passover, when His parents left Jerusalem to go home, where did Jesus stay?
- What was He doing there?
- Jesus is God - did He still obey His parents? (Hint: read verse 51)



## WAYS TO WORSHIP

Using your favorite music app or by finding online, play the song *More Like Jesus* by Passion. Close your eyes and listen carefully to the lyrics as the song plays.

- What does this song tell us that Jesus did?
- Can we, on our own power, change ourselves to be more like Jesus?
- What does it mean for us to lay our desires at the feet of Jesus?



## THINK ABOUT IT

**Read:** Colossians 1:9-10, James 1:5

### Talk about it:

The end of Colossians 1:9 says "...We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives."

- According to Colossians 1:9, where does knowledge of God's will come from?
- If we don't feel like we have wisdom, what does James 1:5 tell us to do?



## GREEN AND GROWING

'Bubble Blower - cut the bottom off of a plastic water bottle and pull a sock tightly over the open end. Dye a small bowl of dish soap green for a little more color in your fun! Place a plastic trashbag/sheet under the soap dish and plate." A plastic sheet or trash bag under the soap dish and the plate is also not a bad idea!

Someone say "ready, set, grow!" Take your bubble blower, dip the sock end into the bubble solution dish and blow through the end from which you'd normally drink. As you blow, you should create a string of bubbles which you will want to masterfully pile onto a plate in front of you. Take turns as a family and see who can make the tallest tower in 90 seconds!
